Kiveton Park Station

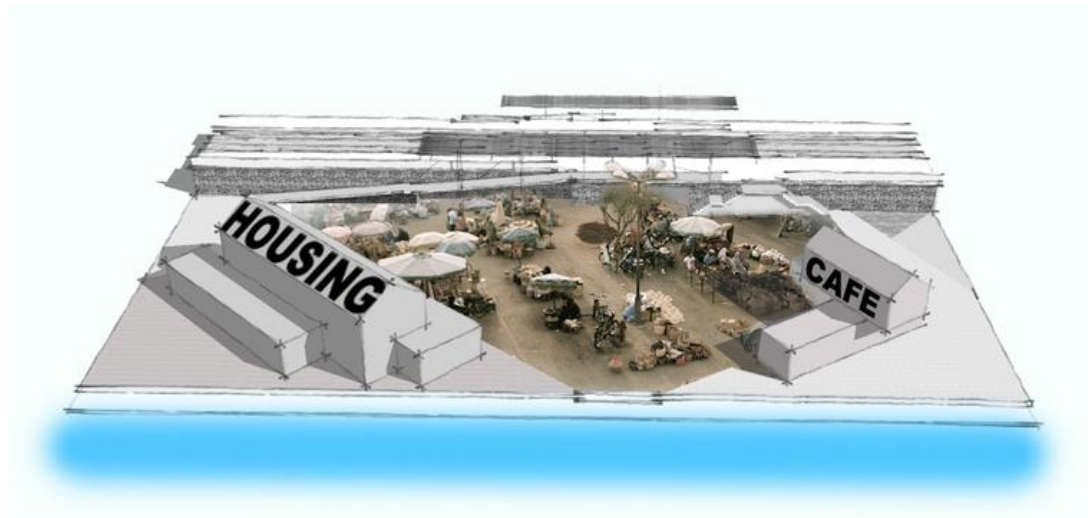
Kiveton Park Station is a popular & valued local amenity on the Sheffield to Lincoln line. Serving residents of Todwick, Anston, Kiveton, Harthill & Thorpe Salvin.

It is ideally situated for a potentially large catchment, however not being within easy walking distance restricts its usefulness. While accessible using bus connections the vast majority of people wishing to utilise the service seek to drive and park at the station, but the existing parking facilities are severely inadequate to accommodate the numbers of commuters and day trippers that would otherwise regularly use the service.

Located close to the existing station and by the recently restored Chesterfield canal, two brownfield sites are currently a blight to the beautiful surroundings. It is proposed to transform this site, providing the desired level of parking for the station and also for improved access to the canal for walkers, fisherman etc.



Relocating the Station creates a new Public space, a square for farmers markets and public gatherings, a Cafe // Restaurant and affordable Live // Work Studio housing.



A Self Funding Project, where returns from housing investment and business opportunities fund the new station.

The proposals greatly enhance the Station, Canal infrastructure, boost the local economy and provide an exceptional public amenity.
